

POST GRADUATE COURSE IN ASSAMESE (SELF FINANCING)

Khagarijan College has regular Post Graduate Course only in Assamese under Gauhati University. Post Graduate class in Assamese was introduced in the year 2015. For P G students; the college has a very good departmental Library. The students are taken to various places or institutions for course-oriented field visit. For the better development of the students of PG class, the department organizes special classes. Experts from specific fields (included in syllabus from various Universities of Assam) are invited to deliver lectures in order to benefit the students. At present, the student intake in PG Class is 25 only. The Admission process starts in the month of July. Admission to PG class is done according to Gauhati University guidelines.



BACHELOR OF COMPUTER APPLICATION (SELF FINANCING)

The College offers Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA) in of regular mode under Gauhati University on Self Financing basis. The duration of courses is three years. The students qualifying H.S. in Science/Arts/Commerce are eligible for admission in the course. Students completing Diploma in SSE/IT from AICTE recognised institutes are also eligible. The admission process starts immediately after the declaration of H.S. final result.

GAUHATI UNIVERSITY UNDER GRADUATE CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (UG-CBCS)

AN OUTLINE OF UG-CBCS

The undergraduate degree (UG) programme in the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) will have courses spread across six-semesters of any undergraduate degree course. Two consecutive (one odd and one even) semesters will make up an academic year. An UG course shall be of Six Semesters covering three Calendar Years (Academic Sessions – June to May). The duration of the Odd Semesters (First, Third, and Fifth) shall be June - November, and that of Even Semesters (Second, Fourth and Sixth) shall be December - May.

THE NOTION OF CREDIT

A student needs to earn a required number of credits in order to successfully complete a degree. The credit is closely related to the number of stipulated classes a student has to complete. The following table indicates the number of credit a student can earn for each type of indicated classes.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

ONLINE ADMISSION PROCESS

FOR ONLINE ADMISSION PROCESS THE STUDENTS HAVE TO GO THROUGH THE UNDERMENTIONED INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY

- Firstly all applicants need to visit the website khagarijancollege.co.in and click on the online admission button or click direct to the link www. khagarijancollege.co.in/online
- After that visit the online portal.
- Thereafter applicants need to click to Apply Online button where they need to click on New Enrollment link to do new registration (if not registered).
- After filling up the registration form mention, applicants need to click again to the apply online button where they need to put user ID as phone and password mention on registration form.
- After login, the applicants need to pay the prospectus fees for generating application form on their login panel.
- After completion of the payment successfully you will get the application form.
- The entire application form will be divided into four sections viz., personal details, photo and signature, educational details, documentation.
- After filling up all the four sections carefully, you will get a preview of the input data for your confirmation to the final submission of the application form.
- After confirmation of the applictaion form you can download the filled up form.

OFFLINE ADMISSION PROCESS

Degree Admission process for the new academic session will start immediately after the declaration of AHSEC result. Last date of submission of application form will be within 15 days of declaration of AHSEC result.

- Admission will be strictly on the basis of merit and students from other board applicants will be standardized according to the AHSEC.
- 2. Candidates must take admission within the stipulated period after release of the merit list. Otherwise, their seats will be termed cancelled.
- 3. All Original Documents relevant to the admission procedure must be produced at the time of Admission.
- 4. Incomplete form or forms without documents will be rejected.

- 5. No forms will be accepted after the last date of submission under any circumstances.
- 6. Subject combination cannot be changed after admission.
- 7. The merit list for 'Reserved Category' will be prepared as per Government Rules.
- Students claiming seats against Co-curricular category must submit a separate application on plain paper. Only State and National level certificates will be entertained.
- 9. In case the candidate who has studied the subject in 10+2 level in which he/she desires to take Major (only in case of those subjects which are allowed as per GU regulations), his/her eligibility will be considered on the basis of aggregate percentage.
- 10 A candidate will have to submit a duly attested photocopy of the mark sheet of the last qualifying examination and caste certificate/certificate of Differently Abled (whether applicable) at the time of admission. No other documents are required with the application form.
- 11. A candidate shall have to produce the following documents in ORIGINAL along with the Photo copies at the time of interview.
 - · Original Admit Card of the HSLC Examination for age verification.
 - Original Marks Sheet of the last examination appeared.
 - · Registration Card.
 - Caste Certificate (SC/ST/OBC) where necessary.
 - Pass Certificate from the Head Master/Principal of the institution last attended by the candidate.
 - Proficiency certificate regarding extra-curricular activities where necessary.
 - In case of students migrating from another University or Board, Migration Certificate has to be produced.
- 12. Students passing the qualifying examination earlier than the current year will have to submit a Gap Certificate from the Head of the institution last attended or OC of nearest Police Station or a Government Gazette Officer testifying to his/her activities during the interim period. A candidate having more than Three Years period of Gap will not be eligible for Admission.
- 13 TDC first year students who fail to get promotion to the next higher class may apply for fresh admission.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

COLLEGE UNIFORM

The College uniform is compulsory for all students. The uniform will be as follows-

FOR BOYS

Black pant (Formal only) and White Shirt with College Logo.

FOR GIRLS

- A) Muga or Muga colour Mekhela, Chaddar with Deep Pink border and White Blouse.
- B) White Salwar, White Kameez (Knee length) and Deep Pink Dupatta. Marron Sweater and Black Shoes/Sandal are common to both boys and girls.

IDENTITY CARD

Identity Card will be issued to every bonafide students which automatically continue up to the successive years. The identity cards are valid after the signature of the Principal. The students must keep their identity cards with them during the college hours and have to produce them on demand by the Principal or duly authorized representative of the Principal. If a student loses Identity card, a duplicate card will be issued after an application to the Principal.

EXAMINATION RULES

All examinations of the college will be conducted by the College Examination Committee. The students must appear in all the examinations conducted by the college during an academic year, otherwise they will not be allowed to sit in the Final Examination. The examination schedule is embodied in the Academic Calendar of the college.

TDC Semester students are to take admission in next promotional classes after appearing in their respective final examinations. A candidate will get 3 chances in each Part of TDC but in all parts will get 5 years only. (Ref: Reguation: 12, G.U.)

ATTENDANCE RULE

TDC SEMESTERS-I, II, III, IV, V & V)

A student shall not be eligible to sit for the end semester examination as a regular candidate if he/she does not attend a minimum of 75% lectures delivered in each subject separately or 6 credits per week /per paper (GU UG-CBCS Regulation). Students who fail to attend their classes at a stretch for a certain period of time on genuine, reasonable and acceptable ground such as serious disease or accident or related treatment involving themselves and member (s) of their family, death of near and dear ones, academic, sports and cultural activities approved by the college etc. must apply in writing to the Principal through the Head of the Department concerned for consideration of examination or the absence for the period, immediately after such absence. Application must be supported with testimonials/documents wherever necessary. Even for such cases the actual attendance must not fall short of 50%. Scholarship holders with less than 75% attendance will be deprived of the scholarship.

STUDENTS' CODE OF CONDUCT

- Students must come to the college invariably with prescribed uniform and identity cards. This rule is considered as minimum in maintaining discipline of the college.
- Ragging in any form, inside and outside the campus, is strictly prohibited by law. Any student found indulging in ragging will be dealt with as per the directives of Supreme Court/High Court.
- The college campus is a No Smoking/No Tobacco/ No Drugs/No Alcohol Zone. Students found violating these instructions will be dealt with as per rules of the college.
- Students should no damage the property of the institution. Cost of any damage will be recovered from the student.
- Students will not indulging in any anti-social activities or activities causing hindrance to the academic and administrative functioning of the college.
- Those found indulging in such activities will be punished and the authority will take disciplinary action against them.
- During teaching hours all areas around the classrooms will be observed as silent Zones. The authority will deal with students who create disturbance, as they deem right.

COLLEGE LIBRARY

Khagarijan College has a Central library with more than 15,548 books and a reading room of 60 students. It has all kinds of books, syllabus, and Reference books, Journals Newspapers, Magazines and Periodicals etc. The library remains open from 10 A.M. to 4 P.M. on all working days. Moreover, most of the departments of the college have an individual library called Departmental Library, which provides additional help to students and teachers in their academic pursuits.

LIBRARY RULES

- The Library card is not transferable.
- Each Student is allowed to borrow two books at a time.
- Books are issued to the students for a period of 15 days only.
- An overdue charge of Rs. 5/ only per day is levied if a book is kept beyond the due date.
- Borrowers must check the physical condition of the book before getting them.
- References, books marked restricted and bound volumes of periodicals and question papers are not issued.
- A fine of Rs. 20/- will be charged for reissue of library card.



HOSTEL FACILITY FOR GIRLS'

Khagarijan College has only one Girls' Hostel of its own in the college premises. The college hostel may be considered an integral part of the college. The students are required to maintain a healthy and congenial atmosphere in the Hostel. The internal management of the Hostel is looked after by the resident warden. A committee comprising of the Principal, Hostel Warden and two members from the Teaching Staff looks after the smooth functioning of the Hostel.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION INTO THE HOSTEL

- •Admission to the Hostel is granted only after the college Admission is finalized.
- Number of Hostel seats is limited and admission is made strictly on the basis of merit.
 - ·Only outstation students are eligible for admission.
- Admission is finalized after a personal interview with the candidate's parents or local guardian.
