The resource person further emphasized on the history of demonetization in India when such steps had been undertaken for various reasons.

Furthermore, the resource person stated that RBI on August 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017 released its report on the entire process and situation analysis.

An interaction session followed the keynote lecture where students posed various queries on the mechanism, goal and ethical side of the situation. The session was concluded with a Vote of Thanks delivered by Mrs Umme Salma, Assistant Professor, Dept of Economics, Khagarijan College, Nagaon, Assam.




Figure 3: Workshop on Holistic Development




Figure 4: Resource Person interaction session




Figure 91: Flyer of the event




Figure 92: Screenshot of event
