


Figure 6: Certified list of events with ICT Academy


Outcome/Feedback: The course has been greatly beneficial for the participants. The enrolled students have undergone practical lab training to attain the skill and have emerged well trained from it.




Figure 10: Online Yoga Workshop




Figure 17: Training session in Sadau Asom GramyaPuthi Bharal
