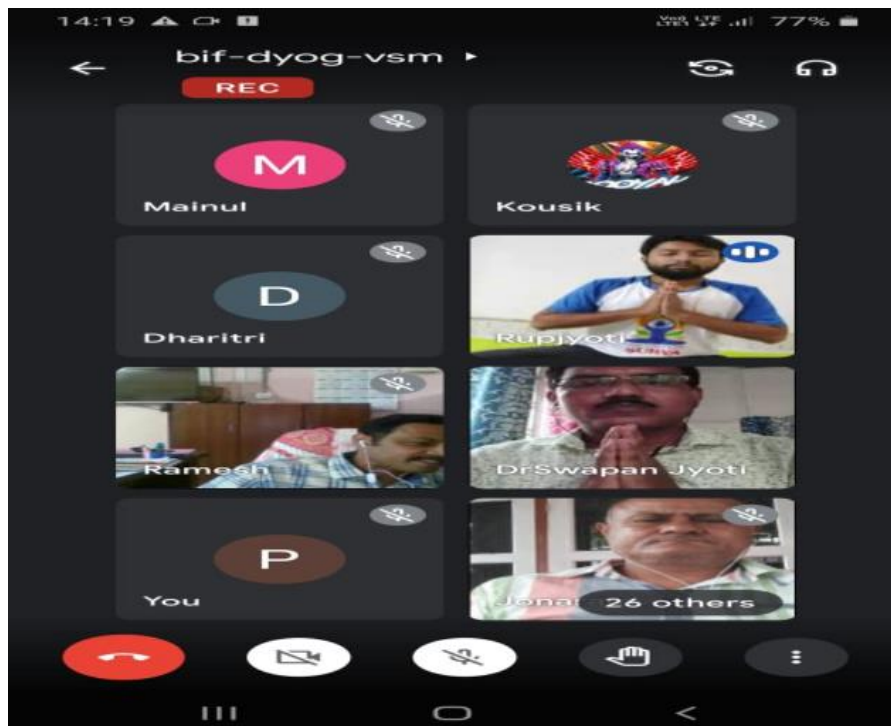



Figure 1: Screenshot of the Online Yoga Workshop

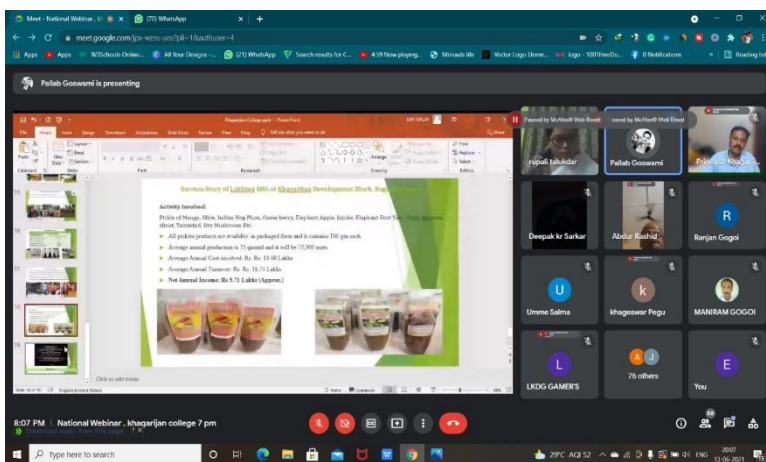

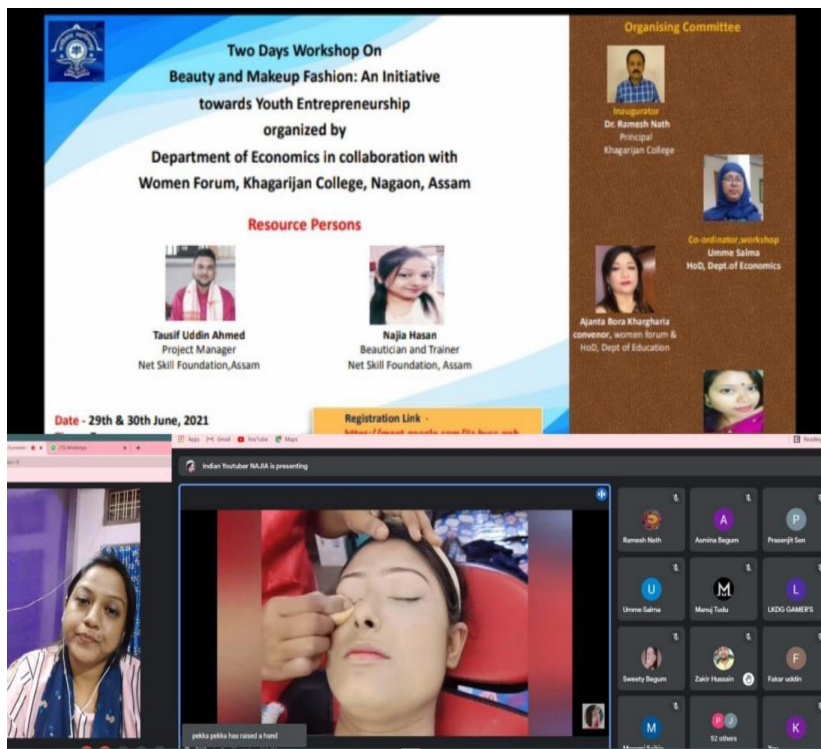
