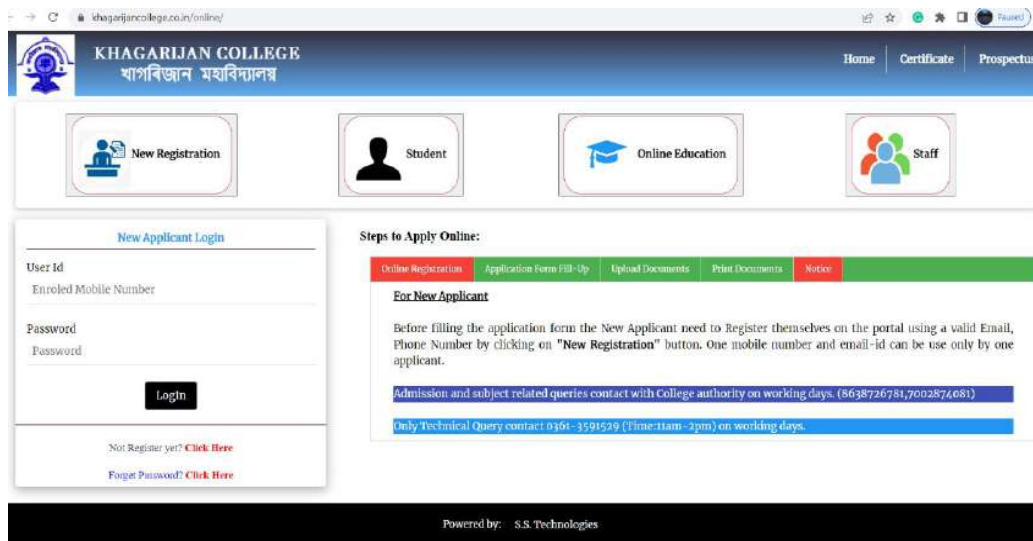


Figure 10: College Automation designed by SS Technologies

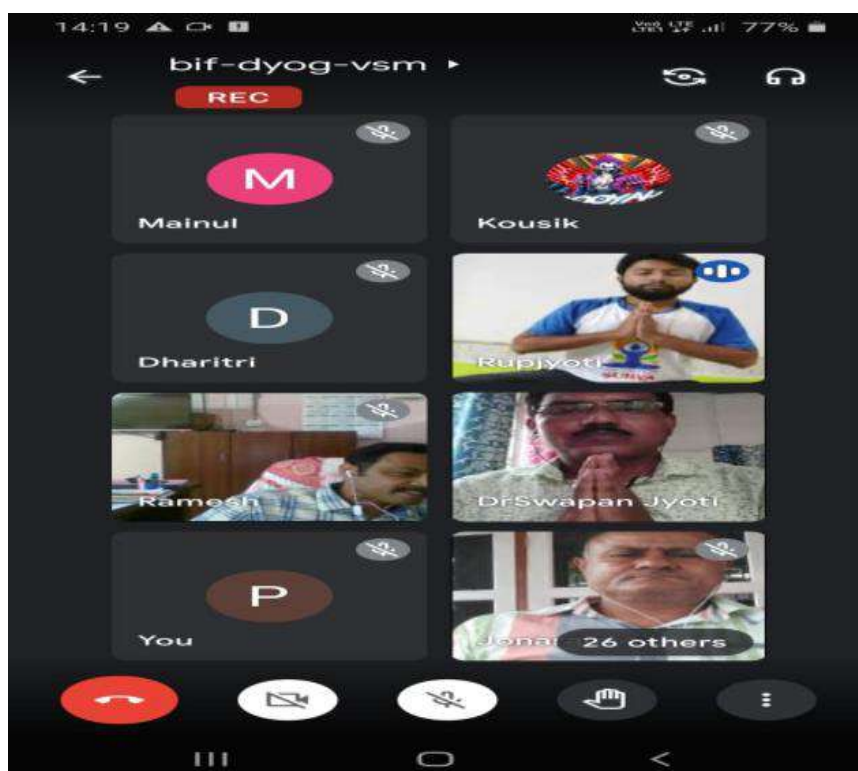


Figure 12: Online yoga Workshop

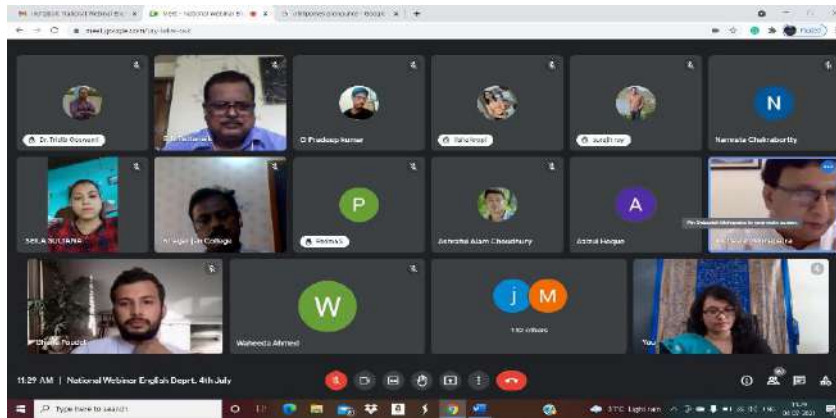


Figure 16: A glimpse of the Webinar on Trends in ELT

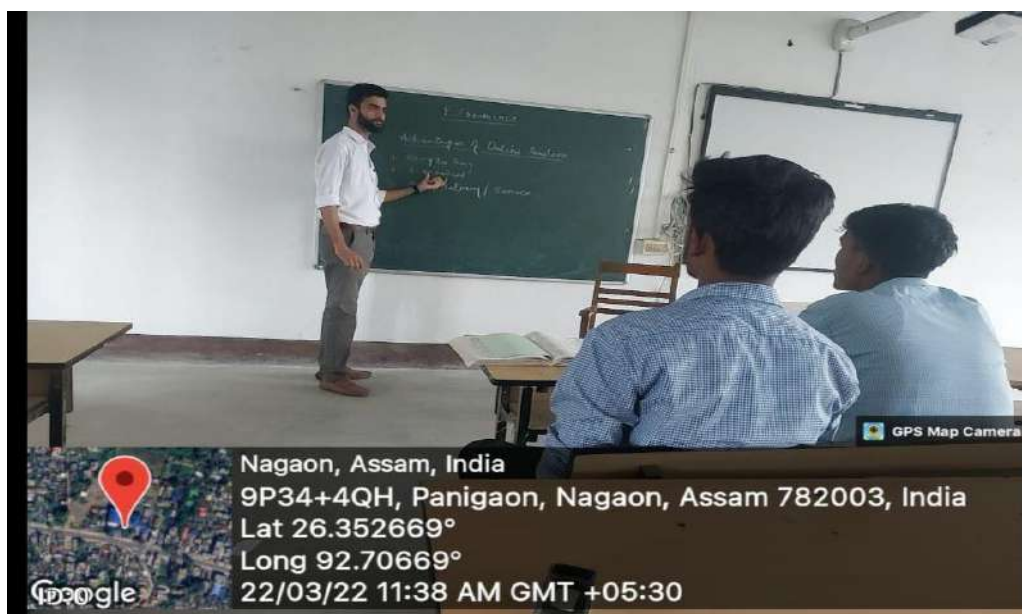


Figure 33: A glimpse of Faculty Exchange

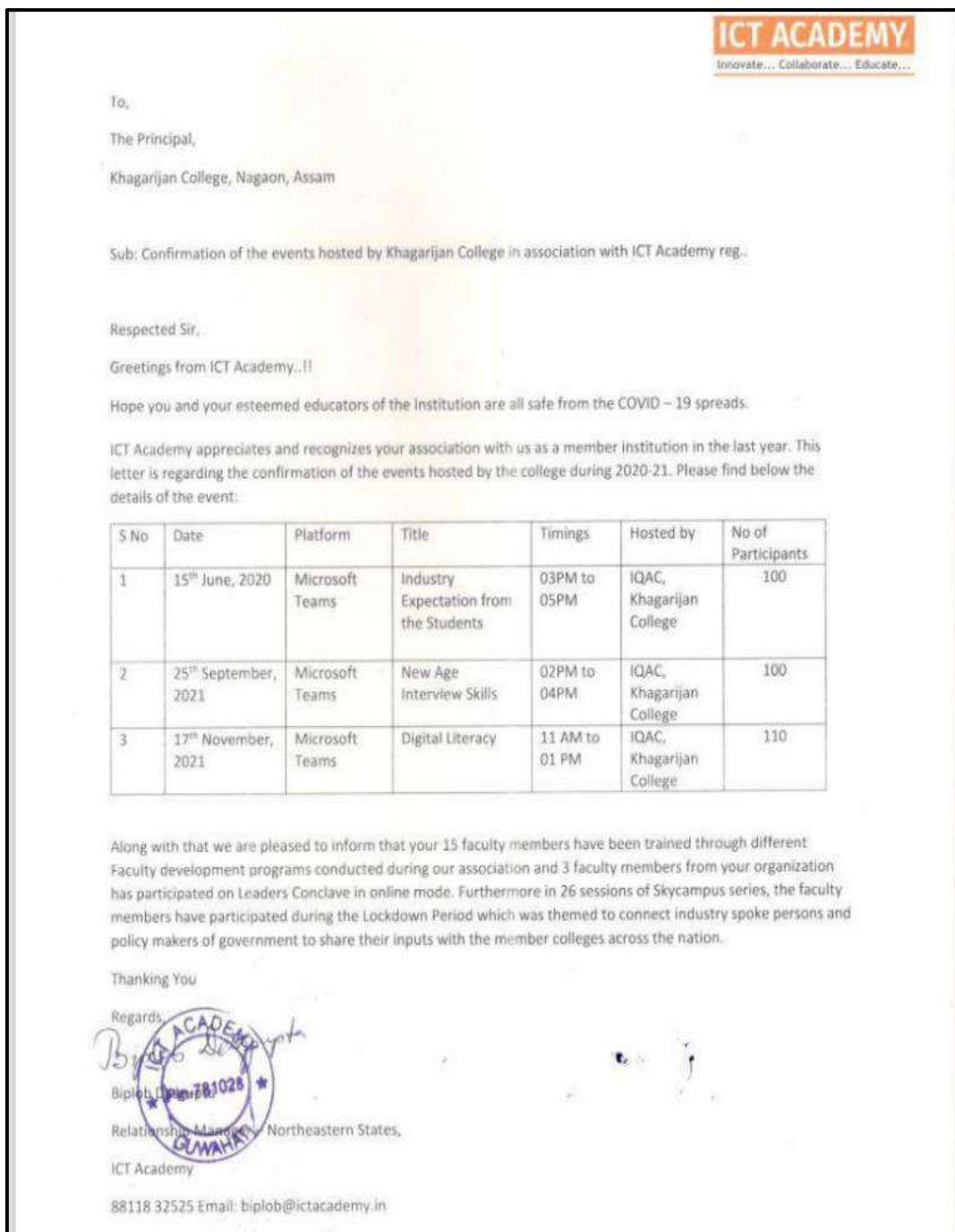


Figure 6: Certified list of events with ICT Academy

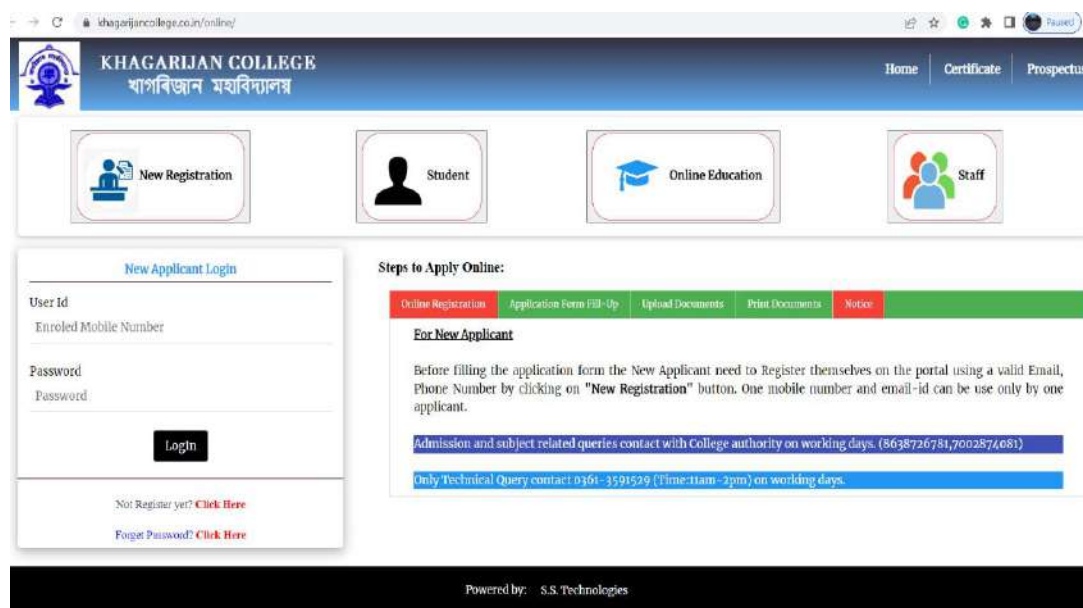


Figure 8: College Automation

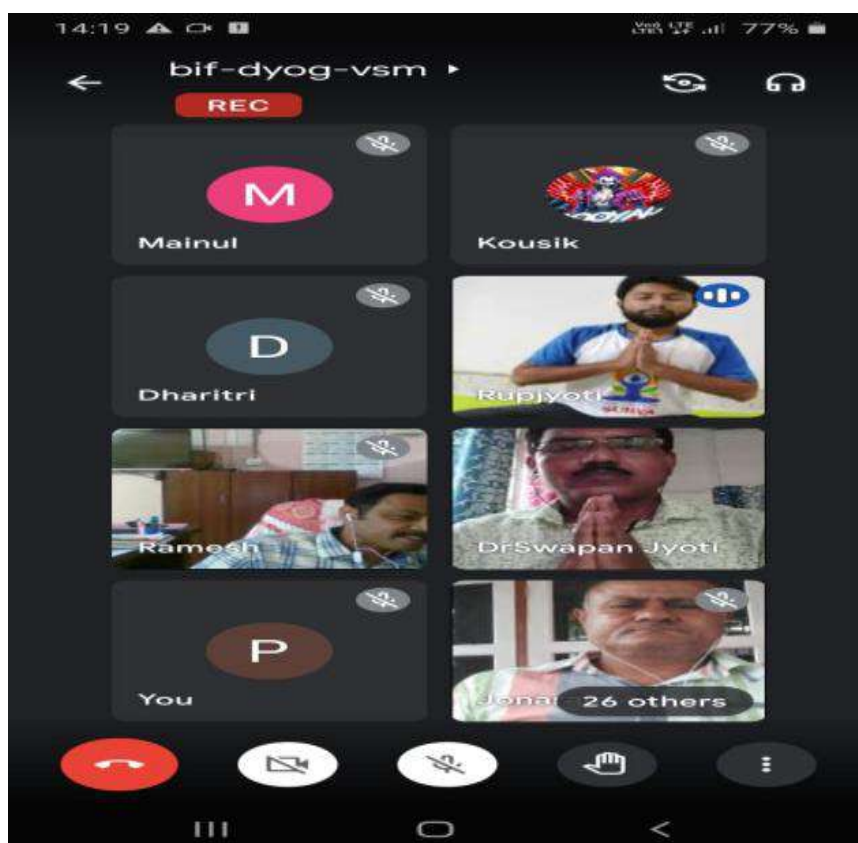


Figure 10: Online Yoga Workshop

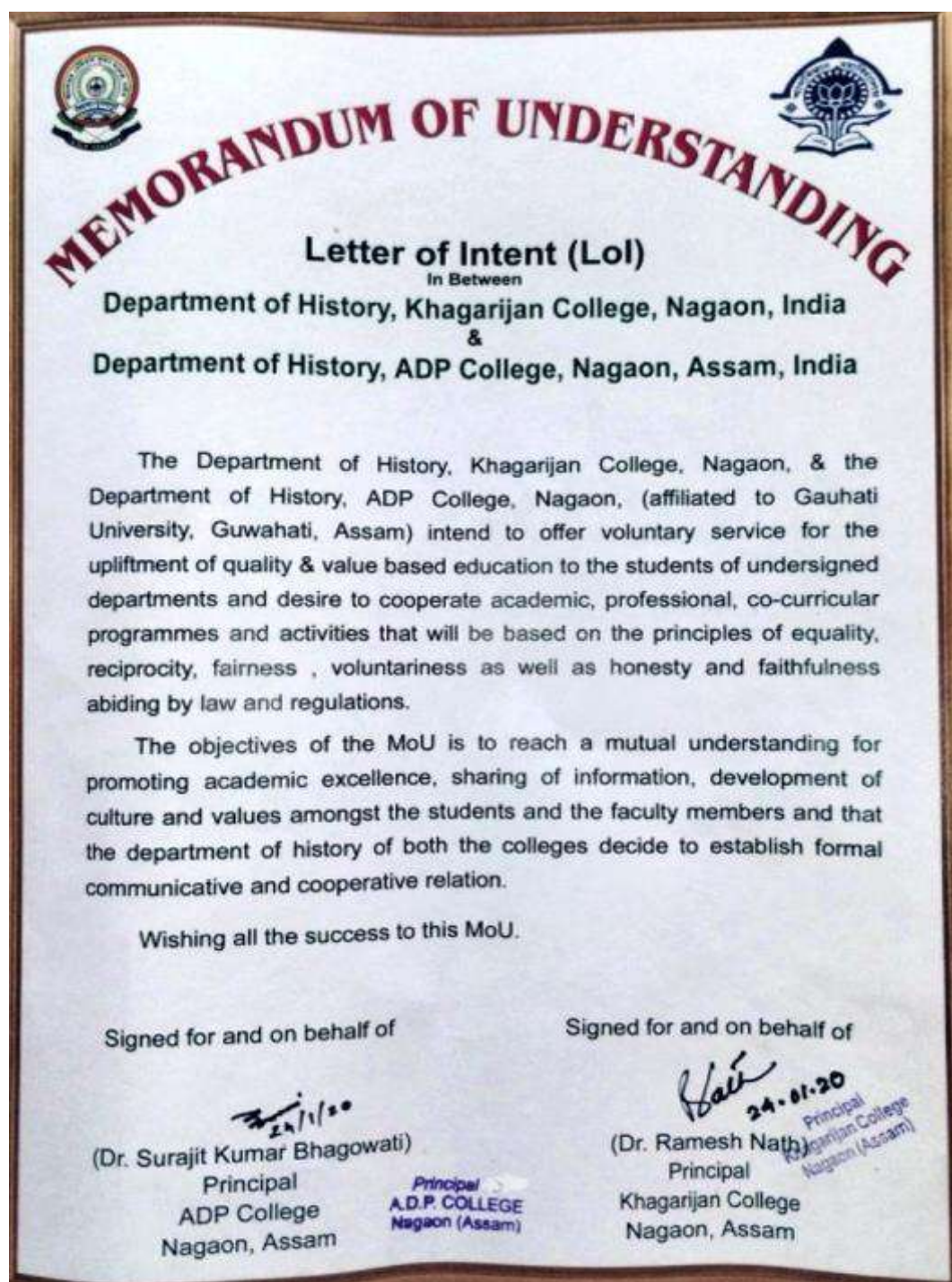



  - xi) not use the equipments and other properties received from the University for any other purpose without written permission from the University;
  - xii) convey to the learners various information and instructions issued by the University from time to time;
  - xiii) display prominently a signboard of KKHSOU Study Centre with the emblem of the University as in reverse page superscribed on it ;
  - xiv) provide space for Notice Board / Wall Magazine for the learners of the Centre
  - xv) allow the authorized officer of the University to inspect the functioning of the Study Centre as and when necessary;
  - xvi) give 6 (six) month's notice to the University in the event of its unilateral decision to discontinue as Study Centre and take full responsibility of the enrolled learner's future on its failure to do so.

##### Location of Activities

- a. The Parties agrees to implement the activities stated in Article II at KC and MUMV.
- b. Any changes to the location of the activities shall be mutually agreed upon by the Parties.





**Article IV  
Executing Agencies**

To implement this MoU:-

**Article V**

**Financial Arrangements**

In the event that either Party wish to disclose any data and/or information supplied in or resulted from the implementation of this MoU, the disclosing Party shall have prior written consent of the other Party.

**Article VIII**

**Limitations of Personal Activities**

The Parties shall ensure that their personnel engaged in the activities under this MoU shall engage only in activities under the framework of this MoU with respect to laws and regulations in the state of Assam and country of India.

**Article IX**

**Settlement of Duties**

Any dispute concerning the interpretation of this MoU shall be settled amicably through consultations or negotiation between Parties.

**Article X**

**Amendment**

- a. This MoU may be amended or revised at any point of time by mutual written consent of the Parties, and such amendment shall form an integral part of this MoU.
- b. Such amendment or written or revision shall come into force on the date as may be determined by the Parties.



**Article XI**

**Entry into Force, Duration and Termination**

- a. This MoU shall come into force from the date of signing i.e., 01/04/2022.
- b. This MoU shall remain in force for a period of **Three Years** and may be extended for another period of **Three Years** by mutual agreement of the Parties.
- c. Either Party may terminate this MoU at any point of time by giving written notification to the other Party on its intention to terminate this MoU, **one** month prior to the termination.
- d. The termination of this MoU shall not affect the completion of any programmes, activities or projects in progress and not completed at the time of termination.
