


Figure 8: Certified list of events with ICT Academy




Figure 27: Awareness programme on Child Marriage




Figure 6: Certified list of events with ICT Academy




Figure 8: College Automation




Figure 10: Online Yoga Workshop




Figure 19: Flyer of the Webinar on World Environment Day
