## Awareness Programme on "Rising Energy Demand: Deforestation and Climate Change" on 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2022

On 3rd January 2022, an awareness programme on the rising energy demand, deforestation, and climate change was organized by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Khagarijan College, Nagaon, Assam. The event was conducted in collaboration with the United National Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) and featured Mr. Debajit Das, the National Project Coordinator at UNIDO in New Delhi, as the resource person. The primary objectives of the awareness programme were as follows: a. To raise awareness about the escalating energy demand and its implications, to highlight the correlation between deforestation and climate change, to educate participants about sustainable energy practices and their role in mitigating climate change, to foster a sense of responsibility, and motivate participants to act in their daily lives. The programme began with an opening address by the Principal of Khagarijan College, emphasizing the importance of addressing the energy crisis and environmental issues. 



A Training Programme on Disaster Management was organized by IQAC Khagarijan College in collaboration with Assam State Disaster Management Authority & 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion NDRF, Guwahati on 24<sup>th</sup> October 2019 on the college campus. Inspector Ranvijay Singh from the 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion NDRF, Mr. Titu Das, Field Officer/Nodal Officer of the Nagaon Disaster Management Authority Team, and five Rescue Officers of NDRF namely Mr. Banshraj Yadav, Mr. Bhumidhar Rabha, Mr. Mrinal Kumar Nath, Mr. Jaduram Rabha and Mr. S. Hazarika graced the occasion.

The training session was formally inaugurated by Dr. Ramesh Nath, Principal, Khagarijan College who extended warm greetings to the Disaster Management team of Nagaon as well as the NDRF Battalion for giving the students the opportunity of getting first-hand demonstration and training from people with such expertise.

Inspector Ranvijay Singh acted as the moderator of the demonstration and explained various measures that can be taken up in case of sudden disasters that threaten life. The Rescue Officers demonstrated life-saving techniques like Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), acupressure, etc. They further depicted methods to use a Fire Extinguisher, measures to tackle the venom from reaching the heart in case of snake bites, etc. Various student and faculty volunteers participated in the demonstration so that it could be easily enacted for the entire audience.

They were also made to practice the method sequences like learning CPR and acupressure so that the technique can be retained as a skill through practice and muscle memory. The training session was concluded with a Vote of Thanks by Mr. C.K. Lungking, Assistant Professor, Dept of Education. The session was attended by 125 students, apart from faculty members and other staff of the college.
