As per the discussion with the Principal, Dr. Ramesh Nath and the Coordinator of IQAC, the Mentoring Cell of the College has planned to mentor the students for the academic session 2020-2021. For that, I am herewith enclosing the student data containing Roll Nos, Class and contact numbers for effective coordination.

Guidelines for Student Mentoring:

The Mentor-Mentee system of the college is designed to help the students in various academic & non-academic issues arising out in their day to day life. As per the mechanism, the students of particular departments are entrusted to the respective department or in cross cutting line for teaching learning and consultancy services. For attainment of good result from the student mentoring, the mentors are instructed to follow the following guidelines:

- 1. HoD of the respective department will hand over the list of the students to the Mentors.
- 2. The approved mentor will organize meeting with the students in monthly basis.
- 3. The Notification of the meeting should be displayed on Notice Board by the concerned mentor.
- 4. The Mentors will record the issues faced by the students in classroom, career planning and other related issues.
- 5. The Minutes will be prepared at the end of the meeting.
- 6. The Minutes will be followed by the recommendations of HoD of the respective departments.
- 7. The HoD will resolve the issue raised by the students with an Action Taken Report.
- 8. Unable to resolve the same the HoD will forward the resolution to Head of the Institution.

Organizational Set-Up:

Students of each semester on the basis of their Roll No., Name will be divided among the approved Mentors (Full Time Faculty Members) for mentoring academic and Non-Academic issues of the students.

Point to be noted that that Mentors should be organized on cross cutting manner, as for example, one Political Science Faculty should not be given responsibility to his own department students instead he should be given responsibility to the other departments.

- 3. Prepare Minutes and will sent the same to the concerned HoD

FINAL REPORT

The Mentor-Mentee meeting was held on November 10, 2020 to cater the various academic and other issues of students. C.K. Lungking, Assistant Professor, Department of Education and Bediskiva Nath, Assistant Professor, Department of English is allotted to mentor the students of the Economics Department as per list provided by the convenor. There was an interaction between the students and the mentor in the during the meeting. The students express their issues and problems as well come forth with their suggestions. There were some important discussions in the meeting where suggestions regarding requirement of extra classes (remedial) and issues of text books in Assamese were highlighted. These inputs were forwarded to the HoD of the Department Mrs. Umme Salma. The concerned HoD discussed the issues in departmental meeting held among the faculty members to reach a suitable conclusion. As per the follow up of the action, remedial lessons are held for the slow learners and others facing difficulty in the pace with strict focus on econometrics portions of the syllabus. The issue regarding textbook availability in Assamese is a problem faced by most of the colleges where students have opted to study Economics in Assamese medium.

MINUTES OF MENTORING Department of History, 2020-2021



Dr. Deepak Kumar Sarkar, Assistant Professor, Dept of Education supervises the Mentor-Mentee session with the students of the Department of History on 4th of December, 2020by 2:00 pm onwards in Room No: 08. Dr. Deepak Kumar Sarkar welcomes all the students and explains the aims and objectives of the mentor mentee system with a conversation favouring the system so that student will understand and get benefit of the system.

In their course of curriculum maximum numbers of students are from Assamese medium. On the other hand, a very less number of students are from English medium. English medium students brings to light the problems of English writing skills, as they are more curious to learn and express the benefits from classroom teaching learning process. Miss Junbai Begum of B.A 1st semester raised an issue that certain concepts are not available in Assamese medium books and hence, books should be available in central library which are written in Assamese language. Mr.Khonsing Teron of B.A 1st semester specially who is from hilly area raise the issue of form fill-up of examinations through online mode as he is facing of electricity and mobile network problem and most of the students are agree with his view point. They also rise about monitory problem as teachers provide notes, instructions etc. about their course through whatsapp group basically in this pandemic period. They also bring into light that they are not able to afford the cost of mobile data as much as possible because most of them belongs to poor background family. But a less number of students are in view of that, supply of study materials and online classes should be continued. Students from B.A 3rd semester express their willingness to visit notable historical places of Assam. All the students express their owe as teachers are cooperative and provide assistance in their difficulties of learning. Notably, some more students have certain difficulties to learn in a single class.

In the long run the mentor concludes the session with affinity and asks them to contact whenever necessary. After long run discussions certain resolutions are adopted.

Resolutions:

- 1) It is resolved that the faculties of the department would be request to arrange an educational tour in historical areas of Assam.
- 2) The issues faced regarding text books in Assamese will be duly informed to the authorities.
- 3) It is resolved that extra classes (remedial) would be arranged especially for the slow learners.
- 4) It is resolved that wi-fi connection should be available at the college campus without any cost for learners.
- 5) It is also resolved that teachers will provide financial support through Students' Welfare Fund basically who are from poor economic background.

A meeting for mentoring major students of the department of English is organized by Mrs. Umme Salma, Assistant Professor, and Department of Economicson 29th December, 2020 at 2:00 pm in Room No. 04, Khagarijan College.

Mrs. Umme Salma gratified all the students delightfully. She explained the objective of the meeting briefly. The motive of the meeting is to find out the problems faced by the students in the academic and non-academic areas. Miss Sima Devi, Assistant Professor, Department of Assamese stated about the benefits of the programmed and assured them of the possible suggestions.

The students are ensured to share all their issues regarding course-curriculum, teaching method, class routine, slow learning, language and communication problem etc.

<u>Final Report of the Mentor - Mentee Cell for the Session 2020-21</u> <u>Khagarijan College, Nagaon, Assam</u>

As per the letter circulated dated 12th June, 2020, Mr. Mainul Hoque Akanda, the convenor of the Mentor -Mentee Cell supervised the allotment of mentors to respective departments. This system has seen an interesting growth since its onset in this academic session. After the allotment, the mentors proceeded to hold the meetings in feasible dates and in a manner suitable for both the mentors and the mentees. Various observations, issues and suggestions have been received by the convenor as reports from respective sessions.

The entire Mentor-Mentee system had however faced many difficulties in its full fledged operation due to the pandemic situation and consequent lockdown. As such, only a small number of meetings could be organized by the mentors. The reports submitted by the mentors are scrutinized and analyzed in detail by the Mentoring Cell. The common concerns drawn from the observations, along with the possible solutions are summarized below:

- 1) There has been an observation from the side of the students regarding the pace of comprehension amongst the student body. As such Remedial lessons to decrease the gap between slow learners and advanced learners has been put forth as a suitable solution by the Heads of all the departments.
- 2) The students of most of the departments have also requested for an educational tour. This request had been forwarded to the concerned departments. Your permission and guidance in this regard is requested.
- 3) The students have also asked for the number of smart classes to be increased. As such there is a need to increase further infrastructure for the same. The Heads of the departments have also been asked to make full use of the available resources.
- 4) Language proficiency and language comprehension are huge challenges as the students belong to different language backgrounds. As such there is a need for proper infrastructure for a language lab. There is a necessity for a proper discussion with the Heads of all the departments regarding a suitable solution so that the students can avail a multilingual discussion platform and are able to understand the lessons in the language they are well versed in.

Beyond the structured framework, the mentors often take individual initiative to provide guidance to the students regarding various issues, off-campus through telephonic conversations.
