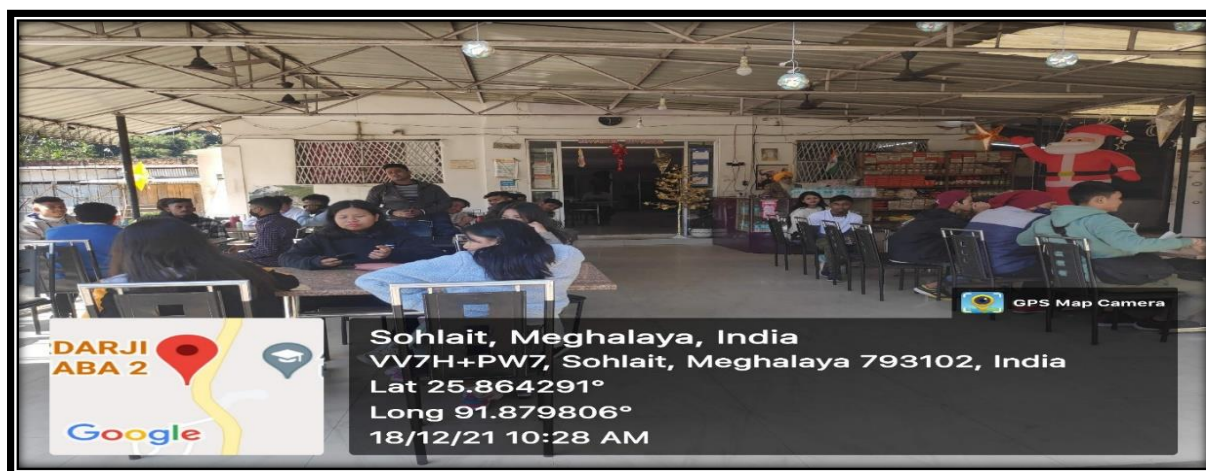
REPORT – EDUCATIONAL TOUR TO SHILLONG AND CHERRAPUNJI Department of English

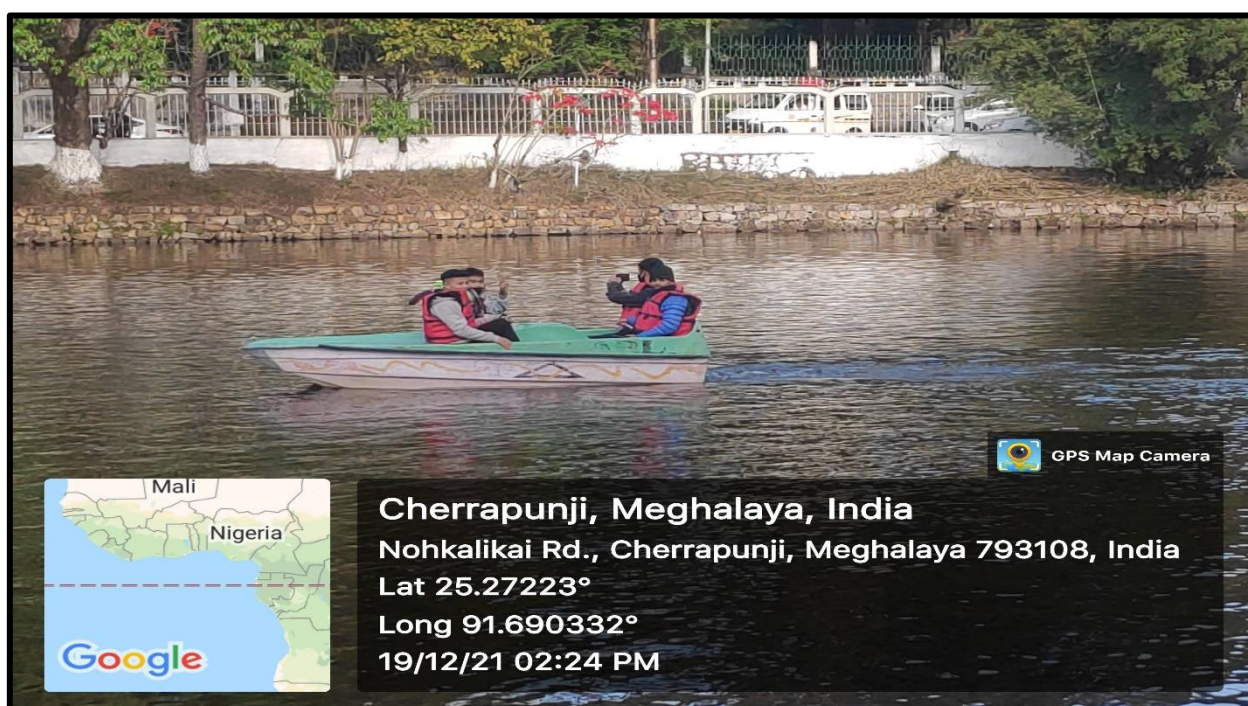

The trip comprised of a tour through the town of Shillong and various tourist places of Cherrapunji. The students were accommodated safely in homestays and were allowed to engage with various people, their cultural beliefs, food habits and interesting legends. The students along with faculty members also engaged in collection of various souvenirs from the local market and many talented students edited interesting compilations, vlogs and videos of the tour; showcasing their technological expertise. trekking places of Meghalaya in future and also a camping trip to Dawki. Most of the students were of the viewpoint that the trip should have been of three days instead of the two-day time period.
