


Figure 1. Security guards at the main entrance of the College gate

















Figure 5. Girls' Hostel Warden and Visitors book at the Campus





#### Admission

   Distance of residence and marks obtained at the lest qualifying examination.
   Any other citiers many be decided by the Hostsi Admission committee.
   No candidate shall be admitted into the hostel unless he/ahe has been admitted into the colege.
   One boarder may have one local guardian. But the local Guardian's must set submitted.
   Hostel numbers of each boarderd, Parent and Local Guardian's must see submitted.

#### Hostel Fees

#### **Mess Management**











Figure 11. Washroom facilities for the teachers










Figure 14. Check-up for Girls Hostel
